KNIB's medication collection is coming up. On Saturday, June 11 you can take unused or expired Rx, over the counter, pet medication, inhalers and mercury thermometers to one of 4 locations. Needles or bio-hazardous materials will ***not*** be accepted. The medications will be properly disposed of, keeping them out of our water supply. The four locations and times for the June 11 drive-up Medication Collection are as follows:

Machesney Park: 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. at Machesney Town Center, 8750 N. Second Street.

South Beloit: 9:00 a.m. to Noon, Fire Department, 429 Gardner Street.

Winnebago: 9:00 a.m. to Noon, Rockford Health Physicians, 102 Landmark Drive

Belvidere: 9:00 a.m. to Noon, Township Office, 8200 Fairgrounds Road

Volunteers from OSF Saint Anthony Medical Center, Rockford Health System, SwedishAmerican, a division of UW Health, University of Illinois College of Pharmacy, local pharmacies, Winnebago County Health Department and Boone County Soil and Water Conservation District to assist at the event.



ALPINE ROAD PROJECT PHASE II



The City of Loves Park has completed the first phase of the Alpine Road between Riverside Boulevard and Rivington Road. The City is now starting on Phase II of the project, which is between Rivington Road and Croydon Avenue.

In addition to resurfacing the roads, new curbs and sidewalks will be installed. The medians will be replaced with a bi-directional turn lane. The intersection of Alpine Road and Maple Avenue will get new right turn lanes so drivers can turn onto Alpine Road from the west side of Maple Avenue and from Alpine onto the east side of Maple.

The project should be completed by the end of August of 2016, and at least one side of the road will remain open throughout construction. Please remember, changing conditions related to work zones can be challenging at times, even for the safest drivers. The City encourages driving slowly through work zones areas to protect your safety while you're getting to your destinations. Driving too fast or recklessly through a work zone is dangerous to your life and passengers, and it is dangerous to workers laboring to improve roadways. We are all responsible for work zone safety, so please use caution and obey speed limits when driving through our work zones. And remember, using handheld phones is illegal when driving anywhere in Illinois through a work zone. Help us help you get there safely.
