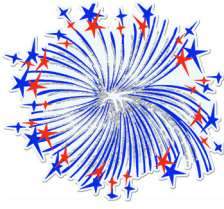

Rock River Water Reclamation District Intergovernment Agreement Alderman Jacobson presented the following resolution authorizing the Mayor to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement between the City of Loves Park, Illinois and Rock River Water Reclamation District. **WHEREAS**, Section 10 of Article VII of the Illinois Constitution of 1970 and Division 147 of the Illinois Municipal Code authorizes units of local government and public agencies to contract or otherwise associate among themselves in any manner not prohibited by law or by ordinance using their credit, revenues and other resources to pay costs and service debts related to intergovernment activities such as the design and construction of the public improvements contemplated by this Agreement; and **WHEREAS**, the Rock River Water Reclamation District is an Illinois unit of local government ("District") and the City of Loves Park is a municipal corporation ("City") governed by the authority cited herein; and **WHEREAS**, the City operates a municipal water system whereby the City provides water to customers and charges customers based in part upon their consumption of City water; and **WHEREAS**, the current water meters do not have the capability to electronically report water consumption and therefore the City relies on the self-reported information from customers; and **WHEREAS**, the District bills its customers utilizing City water based upon the self-reported water consumption data which the City receives from its customers and **WHEREAS**, the City believes that it is in the best interest of the City to install and utilize new water meters that can electronically report a customer's water consumption and, furthermore, enter into an intergovernmental agreement with the District pursuant to the authority cited above, to manage the cost sharing and reimbursement for this said new technology. **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of Loves Park, Illinois, that by the adoption of this resolution, whose recitals are incorporated herein, that the City hereby agrees:
1. The above recitals are hereby incorporated into this Resolution as if fully stated herein.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO HIRE A LICENSE INSPECTOR FOR THE CITY IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 2-211 OF DIVISION 7 OF THE CITY'S CODE OF ORDINANCES

WHEREAS, the City has previously created the position of License Inspector with the duty of determining that all licenses required by the City either have been issued and properly affixed or displayed in accordance with the ordinances of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City does not currently have a License Inspector; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-211 of Division 7 of the City's Code of Ordinances provides that the Mayor may appoint the License Inspector with the advice and consent of Council; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor wishes to appoint Scott Andrews to the position to work part-time to inspect the City's businesses to assure compliance with City Ordinances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Loves Park, County of Winnebago and County of Boone, Illinois, that by the adoption of this resolution, that the Mayor and the City Council hereby agree as follows:

1. The above recitals are hereby incorporated into this Resolution as if fully stated herein.
2. The Mayor is authorized to appoint Scott Andrews to be the City License Inspector with the authority to carry-out the duties and obligations of such position as set forth in City Code.
3. The License Inspector shall work part-time and be paid at a rate of \$23.00 per hour.
4. Should any provision of this Resolution be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the invalidity of such provision shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Resolution.
5. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
